Studying at the University of Turku



Eligibility

An exchange student is anyone who comes to study at the University of Turku through an exchange programme such as ERASMUS, FIRST, NORDPLUS, ISEP, North2North, North-South-South, Erasmus Mundus or a bilateral agreement between the host and the home institutions.

Fulbright and CIMO Scholarship holders are also granted exchange student status. In addition, exchange students need to be nominated by their home university to the University of Turku.

In most cases, the basic requirement for an exchange period is that the applicant is a registered student at an institution of higher education abroad. Some programmes require 2–3 years of studies in the field. All programmes require familiarity with the basic concepts of the disciplines in question. Please note, that each programme

has also specific prerequisites which are listed in the programme descriptions.

Participants in the programmes taught in English should have a good knowledge of the language. Applicants who do not have English as their native language have to provide documentation of their knowledge of English when applying.

How to University of Turku to the University of Turku?

The University of Turku application form for exchange students is electronic and must be filled in carefully at www. utu.fi/en/studying/exchange-students/ apply/


Students coming to the University of Turku through Erasmus Mundus, North2North or ISEP programmes should follow the application procedure of the exchange programme they are participating in.

Learning Agreement (or a study plan,

includes the courses you wish to take during your exchange period) is part of the Application Form. Therefore before filling the application form, you should select carefully what you would like to study in Turku.

Enclosures for the application: 1. Transcript of Records (list of courses you have completed at your home university)

2. Language Assessment Sheet or other proof of your language skills (for non-native speakers, if the Transcript of Records does



not contain the information concerning the language you plan to study in; English or Finnish)



3. Please check with the international coordinator at your home university that they have sent the University of Turku a nomination / official letter of confirmation that you are an exchange student nominated by your home university.

All exchange students should send their enclosures to the International Office: International Office, University of Turku, FI–20014 TURKU, Finland. Erasmus students can also choose to send the enclosures as e-mail attachment to international@utu.fi

The application will not be processed before all the required enclosures have been submitted. Late or incomplete applications will be rejected.

Application procedure

It takes a minimum of 3 weeks to process an application after the deadline (see the box above). All completed applications received by the deadline in April/May will be processed in May/June. The students are notified by June/July. Completed applications for the Spring Semester received by the deadline are processed in October/ November, and students are notified in December the latest.

Our deadlines cannot be extended. It is extremely important that the applications

> arrive by the deadline and are complete so that they can be processed on time.

> Applicants should note that the personnel is on holiday in July and the International Office is usually closed during the holiday season.

> Once a student has been accepted, the Certificate of Admission is sent directly to the student unless otherwise agreed.

The certificate is sent together with an Information.

Package including information on studies, orientation and arrival dates.

Eligibility

As a VGSE PhD student you work on your own research in the VGSE office and contribute to a lively research environment. Application procedure

There are two independent application deadlines for the academic year 2013/2014 (program start October 2013). Most fellowships are allocated in the first application round. The first application period lasts from December 1st, 2012 to January 31st, 2013. During these two months applications for the first deadline will be received. The second deadline is 30 April 2013. The application process consists of the application package and a personal interview with the shortlisted candidates.

International Doctoral Programme in Economics, Italy and France



Open to: applicants with no restriction on nationality with a a Master of Science or a Master of Arts equivalent title as well as to current undergraduate students who will be awarded such a degree before September 25, 2013

The International Doctoral Program in Economics is a three-year program designed for highly qualified and motivated students who wish to acquire the research and analytical skills of the international scientific community in economics. It is designed for students seeking jobs in academia as well as those who wish to acquire the skills of professional academic research to work in government agencies, financial institutions, international agencies, private companies.

Students will be offered one year and a half of intensive course work by an international Faculty composed of both permanent staff of the School and a large

group of Visiting Scholars, and will then proceed to supervised research work, yielding an original dissertation to be discussed in a final, public examination. It is expected that students will produce articles publishable in international journals.

The Programme is jointly offered by Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna and by University of Strasbourg.

Moreover, it is part of a European network – involving the University

of Sussex, Aalborg, Manchester, Paris XIII, Oslo and several others, supporting inter-European exchanges of research students and faculty, within the European Network of Excellence DIME. In addition to the teaching activities, Ph.D. students are nested in a rich research environment, within the Laboratory of Economics and Management (LEM) at the Sant'Anna School, and the Bureau d'Economie Théorique et Appliquée – BETA, where Ph.D. students are encouraged to take part in various ongoing research projects.




Eligibility

The Programme is open to:

• Applicants with no restriction on nationality, must hold a Master of Science (M.Sc.) or a Master of Arts (M.A.) or equivalent title.

• Current undergraduate students who will be awarded such a degree before September 25, 2013, may also apply. In this case, a successful application will be conditional to the subsequent completion of the degree and the transmission to the School of adequate documentation, also in electronic form, no later than September 25, 2013.



Scholarship

Four positions with fellowships (amounting to \pounds 12.500 per year + free meals at school's canteen + Campus facilities) are offered every year. The School reserves the possibility of accepting up to a maximum of two further students whose financial support is provided by other institutions.

The Centre for Macroeconomics and the London School of Economics are hosting the 2013 edition of the European Workshop in Macroeconomics on June 20 and 21 in London. The organizers are Björn Brügemann (VU Amsterdam), Wouter den Haan (LSE), Martin Ellison (University of Oxford), Monika Merz (Universität Wien), Salvador Ortigueira (Universidad



Carlos III.), and Thijs van Rens (University of Warwick).

The conference is primarily intended for advanced graduate students who would like to benefit from presenting in front of an international audience before entering the job market. Young post-docs are also encouraged to apply.

Theoretical and empirical papers from all areas of macroeconomics are welcome. Examples of topics of interest include economic growth and business cycles; asset pricing within a general equilibrium context; dynamics of the income distribution; labor market dynamics; international macroeconomics; monetary and fiscal theory and policy.

Submission of papers in other related areas are encouraged as well.

All presentations are in plenary sessions, and time will be left for informal discussions.

Participants are expected to stay both days.

Please note: We encourage proposals for policy-relevant research on the border of economics and other disciplines, such as political science, sociology, demography, geography and ecology. The best research teams will be invited to present their projects at the EERC research workshop in June 2013 (tentatively planned for June 29-July 1, 2013). Heads of projects must attend the workshop in order to be considered for a grant.

Grants of up to \$12,000 are awarded to individual researchers or small research teams (up to 3 persons) for up to 18 months. Grant size depends on the number participants and specific budget requirements of the project.

Scholars in Residence is a residency program for young academic researchers that promotes the exchange of scholarly research and provides guest residencies for researchers in the humanities, cultural studies and social sciences to

visit their colleagues in Germany and abroad.Young scholars are given the opportunity to forge intensive relationships with other researchers, to pursue joint projects and to develop long-term bilateral collaborations within an international context. The program partners a foreign scholar and German scholar who focus on projects that bear upon the program's annual research themes. Within the focal subject matter, one academic from abroad and one German academic will form a duo team

The Scholars in Residence research themes for 2013/2014 are:

- Culture and climate
- Culture and conflict
- Culture and economics

Residency in the host country lasts between six and eight weeks. The scholar from abroad will travel to Germany as of October 15, 2013, the German scholar will travel to his/

Participation requirements

- assume responsibility for your partner and introduce him/her to the research community in your country through a program you have organized
- as a foreign participant, you should stay in contact with the local Goethe-Institut and be available as a contact person for consultation on projects
- Register free of charge in the Alumni-Portal Deutschland (http://www. alumniportal-deutschland.org), which gives you the opportunity to save a list of your skills and contacts, add to them as necessary, and use them for your personal and professional development.



Master of Laws (LL.M.) Program

We are now accepting applications for the LL.M. class of 2013–14. The application deadline will be April 1, 2013. We will begin making admissions decisions in January 2013, so we strongly encourage you to submit your application well before the stated deadline.

Eligibility requirements

There is one fixed eligibility requirement: applicants must have either (a) graduated from a U.S. law school that is approved by the American Bar Association, (b) obtained a full degree in law from a non-U.S. university or (c) be admitted to practice law in a country other than the U.S. Apart from this, we seek applicants from a variety of backgrounds and with a variety of legal and career interests. We are most interested in applicants from other countries who have completed their prior legal studies with high rank and who intend to return to their home countries to contribute to the legal



profession. We also welcome applications from experienced U.S. lawyers who may uniquely benefit from advanced work here.

English Language Skills

Boston College Law School course work and related academic activities require written and spoken fluency in English. Students must be able to express themselves in both spoken and written English and must read the language with ease. Consequently, you must submit evidence of your English language ability unless either (a) English is your native language, or (b) English was the language of instruction for your entire legal education. We accept the following tests as evidence of your English ability:

- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL). We require a minimum score of at least 100 using the Internet-based test (IBT); or
- International English Language Testing System (IELTS). We require an Overall Band Score of at least 7.5.

Both examinations are administered worldwide.

Application Components

The complete application will include:

- Application form
- Resume or c.v.
- Statement of Purpose
- Two signed letters of recommendation

• Official transcripts with a certified English translation from all of your colleges, universities and graduate and professional schools

• TOEFL or IELTS results

• \$75 Application Fee

Which application to use

There are two possible ways to the LL. M. program: on paper, or electronically through the LSAC web site. We encourage you to submit the paper version of the application, as long as (a) you plan to submit original paper recommendations and transcripts directly to us, and (b) you are asking the appropriate testing service to send your TOEFL or IELTS score report (if required) directly to us. Further information on these conditions appears below.



If either of these conditions does not apply to you, please submit your application electronically through the LSAC web site. Please note that the e-app will become available in early October. If you use the e-app, you must also use the LSAC LL.M. Credential Assembly including the International Service, Transcript Authentication and Evaluation Feature. This enables you to provide all of your application documents to the LSAC, which will in turn forward the relevant documents to each school to which you apply. The LSAC charges applicants \$200 for this service, plus \$21 for each school to which you wish to send an application. These charges are in addition to Boston College Law School's \$75 application fee.

Note: if you are applying electronically, you must pay the \$75 application fee by credit card (Visa, Mastercard, Discover). If you are applying on paper, you may pay the application fee by a check, travelers checks, or a postal money order. If none of these forms of payment is available to you, please contact the LL. M. Office. For further information, see the relevant application instructions.

Financial matters

The estimated cost of study for a single student during the 2012–13 academic year is \$61,670. This figure consists of tuition and fees of \$43,270 and estimated living expenses of \$18,400. It does not include the expenses of travel between the student's home country and the Boston area. The comparable figures for the 2013–14 academic year are likely to be higher.

The United States embassy or consulate in your home country may have additional information on Fulbright Scholarships and other fellowship opportunities. Finally, loan funding may be available from organizations such as Sallie Mae, or Citibank. If you are not a United States citizen or permanent resident, however, these lenders generally require a United States citizen or permanent resident to guarantee the loan.

In addition, Boston College Law School has a limited amount of scholarship funding available to LL.M. students. You may submit your completed financial aid application either with your application for admission, or after you receive an offer of admission. We review your application for

> admission without regard to your financial situation, so submitting a scholarship application will have no effect on whether or not we offer you admission to the LL.M. program. Scholarship awards are made primarily on the basis of financial need.



In addition to a strong foundation in software engineering methods, this 2-years program will offer two specializations: Enterprise Software and Embedded Real-Time Software. The program also includes professional internship opportunities. The language of instruction is English and the program is taught primarily by professors with international experience.

The application deadline for all

We would like to add the most important information about the scholarship opportunities to this study program:

Full-time students admitted to this Master's program in 2013 will automatically receive a tuitionwaiving scholarship. One important disclaimer though: this tuition-waiving scholarship is for students who complete a full-time study load of 30 credit-points (ECTS) per semester. Students who do not complete 30 credit-points per semester will pay tuition fees of € 65 per missing credit point below the required 30 ECTS per semester (fee to be confirmed in February 2013). Past history indicates that over 90% of international students

The academic year starts in September 2013.

who study full-time in this program complete the required 30 ECTS per semester.

At least 12 stipendpaying scholarships are available. These include scholarships of \mathbf{C} 300 per month provided by the IT Academy

program as well as alternative scholarships of € 288 per month provided by the DoRa 9 program.

You don't even have to apply for a

scholarship. All students who apply for admission in this Master's program are automatically considered candidates for scholarships. The top-ranked candidates according to past academic performance and motivation are offered a scholarship together with their admission.

Once you have started the Master's program, you may apply for other scholarships. Some of our industry partners (e.g. Playtech) offer scholarships to enrolled students based on their academic performance. Other scholarships include government study allowances and RAEFOND scholarships for international students.

University of Tartu is in the top 3% of the world's best universities according to The Times Higher Education. Software Engineering Master's degree program has been selected by the Estonian Ministry of Education and Research as one of the winners of the 2008 national competition of the most attractive international Master's programmes in Estonia.





 \cdot A student who is eligible for a grant in accordance with Danish Law regarding the State Education Fund

Institutions: The scholarships are administered by the Danish institutions of higher education, each of which decides which students will receive a scholarship.

Please note: The government scholarship consists of two parts and can be given as full or partial tuition fee waivers and/or grants towards covering your living costs. Programme Description

Alexander The Humboldt von approximately Foundation awards 600 Humboldt Research Fellowships a year (for Postdoctoral Researchers and Experienced Researchers altogether). Their purpose is to allow highly qualified voung foreign doctorate holders to carry out research projects of their choice in Germany. Applications may be submitted for long-term research visits of min. 6 to max. 18 months. A monthly grant of 2,450.00 EUR is currently paid. This may be supplemented by travel and family allowances. Short study trips, congress visits or specialised training, e.g. for technical equipment, cannot however be financed.

Target Group

Alexander The Humboldt von Foundation awards Humboldt Research Fellowships for Experienced Researchers to support long-term research visits (6–18 months, may be split into up to 3 visits) to Germany by foreign academics with above average qualifications who have completed their doctorates no longer than 12 years earlier. Applicants are required to have developed distinct and individual academic profile. Applicants should therefore generally have at least worked as assistant professors or as junior research group leaders or be able to provide evidence of several years of independent academic work. Academics from all over the world specialising in all kinds of disciplines are eligible to apply.

Scholarship Value

A monthly grant of 2,450.00 EUR is paid. This includes a standard mobility allowance and a payment towards health and liability insurance. Additional benefits:

• A research cost contribution of 800.00 EUR per month for the host institute (for natural and engineering



science research projects) or 500.00 EUR (for humanities and social sciences research projects);

- Language grant for a 2- to 4-month intensive language course for the fellowship holder and spouse at selected language institutes in Germany just before commencement of the research visit;
- Standard travel allowance for the research fellowship holder's coming and return journey, unless these costs are born by a third party;
- Additional allowances for accompanying family members for stays of at least 3 months (spouse up to 326.00 EUR and up to 204.00 EUR per child per month);
- Europe allowance for a research visit to a research institute in a different European country (not however the fellowship holder's country of origin) for a limited period of time during the term of the sponsorship, if this is necessary for the conduction of the research project;
- Extensive alumni support after successful completion of the research period, particularly fostering contacts with cooperation partners in Germany throughout the entire academic career of the Humboldt scholar.

Application Requirements

 1. Doctorate or comparable academic degree (Ph.D., C.Sc. or equivalent) awarded no longer than 12 years earlier at the time of receipt of the application. If a doctorate is not possible or usual in the country of origin of the applicant, an application can be made up to 16 years after award of a Master's degree or Diplom with a publication output corresponding to the stage in the applicant's career;

- 2. Individual academic profile of the applicant, substantiated by means of an extensive list of academic publications in journals and by publishers refereed according to international standard;
- 3. Confirmation of a research post as well as a detailed letter of recommendation from an academic host at a research institution in Germany;
- 4. Reference letters from important cooperation partners or academics at the own and other institutes, if possible also from outside the country of origin;
- 5. Language skills: Humanities scholars, social scientists and medics are required to be proficient in German to the extent that this is necessary for successful conduction of the project, otherwise a good knowledge of English is required; natural and engineering scientists are required to have a good command of German or English.
