FINANCIAL SUPPORT:

- Travel to/from the U.S.
- University tuition
- Room and board
- Health insurance
- Required books
- Monthly stipend for incidental expenses







ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Citizen of Ukraine, currently residing and studying in Ukraine
- Over 18 years of age
- Enrolled as an undergraduate at any university, public or private
- Not enrolled in his/her final year of studies at the time of application







ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS (continued):

- Written and spoken English
- Able to begin studies in the United States in August 2019 or January 2020







APPLICATION PACKAGE:

- Online application
- Two letters of recommendation
- Transcripts + certified translation
- Confirmation of the current academic year enrollment (dovidka)
- English language test score report (if available)
